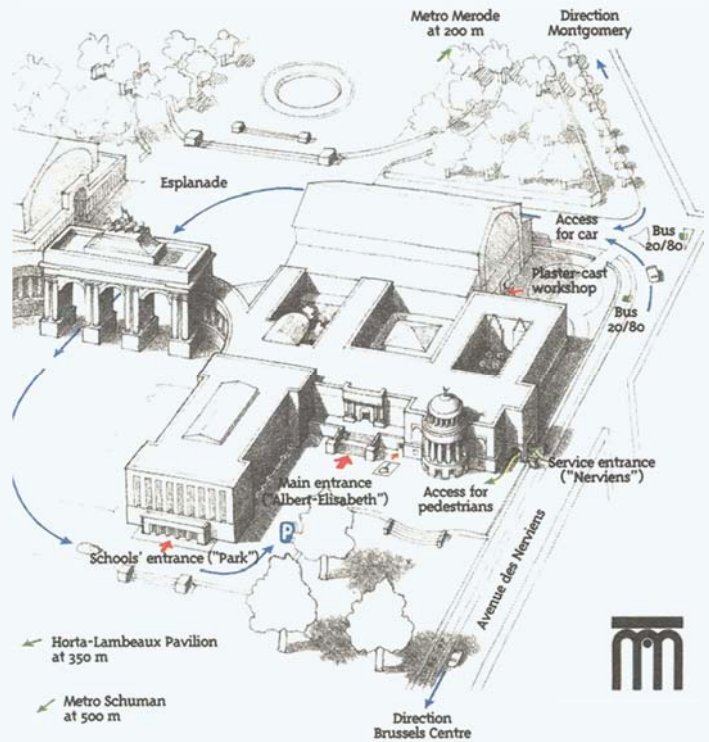

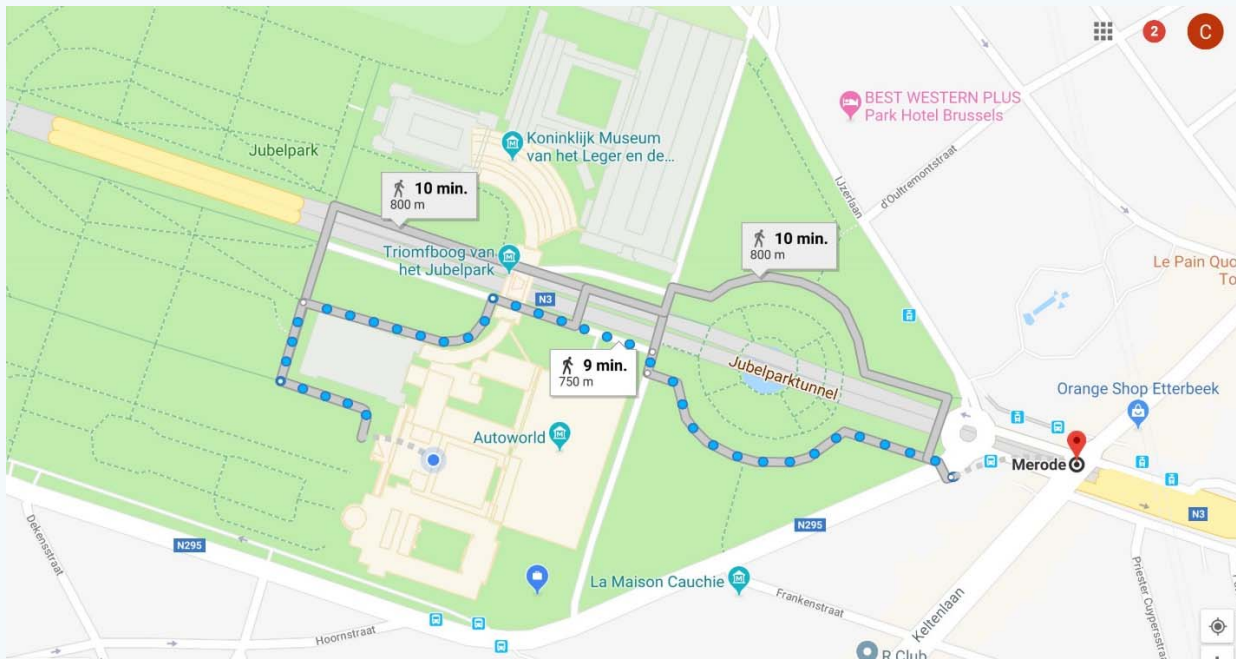

Public transport to venue:

By train: Brussels Central Station is a direct on the Metro lines 1 and 5
By Metro: lines 1 or 5 eastbound; dir. Kraainem or Hermann Dubroux: Merode station



From Brussels Airport:

Train to Brussels: The airport train station is located below the terminal (basement level -1). Up to 4 trains per hour connect the airport to Brussels North, Brussels Central Brussels Midi and Schumann-station. (Schumann is 15 mins walk to the museum). A train ticket will cost approximately € 8.

Airport Bus Line to Brussels: The Airport Line is an express connection (30 minutes) between Brussels National Airport and the European district.

Accommodation Information
