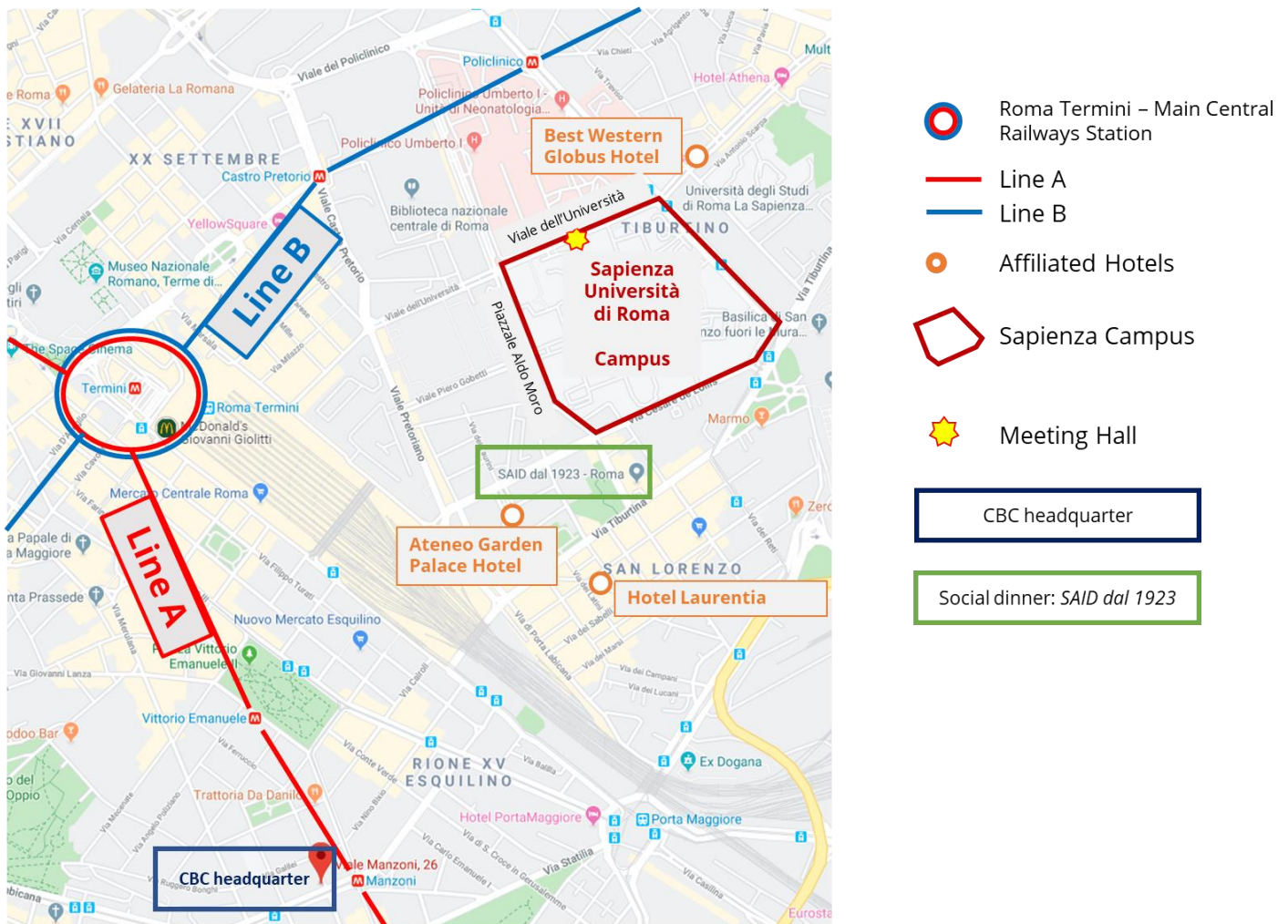

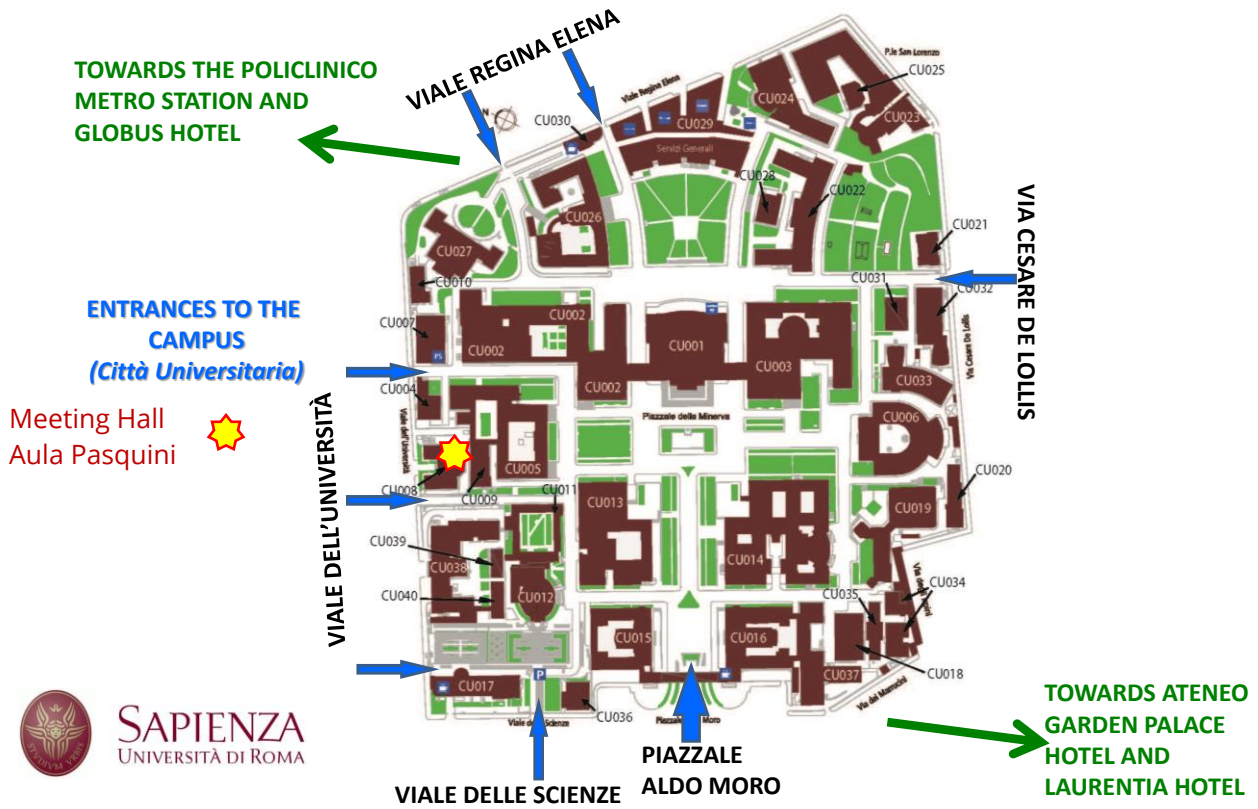
### Meeting hall

## How to reach the venues

### Campus - Sapienza Università di Roma – Viale dell'Università 32

You can easily reach the Campus as well as the meeting hall by walking from each of the affiliated hotel (*less than 15 minutes*).

If you have booked in other structures, you can move by taxi or by public transport. If you choose public transport, you can take metro line B (suggested stop “Policlinico”) and walk to the venue or you can take bus line 310 (stop “Università/Scienze”).

### CBC headquarter – Viale Manzoni 26


You can easily reach the CBC headquarter by taxi or by public transport. If you choose public transport, you can take metro line A (suggested stop “Manzoni”) or you can take tram line 3 or bus line 51 (stop “Manzoni”).

## Public transport tickets

The tickets for public transport are called METREBUS. One single ticket (B.I.T.: Biglietto Integrato a Tempo) costs 1.50 € and it is valid for 100 minutes on buses from first validation and for a single journey on metro/train urban route, even using different lines, but without passing through the turnstiles (English web page of the Public Transport Society ATAC: <https://www.atac.roma.it/page.asp?p=229&i=14>).
